Adoption of Parks, Recreation and Open Space (PRO) Plan and Associated amendments to Sammamish Comprehensive Plan

Notice is hereby given under SMC 24.25.160 that the City of Sammamish City Council will hold a public hearing regarding adoption of the PRO plan and the associated changes to the Sammamish Comprehensive Plan to be held at Sammamish City Hall, 801 228th Avenue SE, Sammamish, WA.

SUMMARY of PROPOSAL:

The City is considering adoption of a revised 2012 Parks, Recreation, and Open Space (PRO) Plan intended to guide future park development and program implementation.

The city's Comprehensive Plan is also proposed to be amended with adoption of selected chapters and a CIP from the 2012 PRO Plan. The PRO Plan currently in Appendix C of the City's Comprehensive Plan would be deleted and replaced with a new Appendix C containing the following:

Chapter 3, Parks
Chapter 4, Athletic Fields
Chapter 5, Recreational Facilities
Chapter 6, Recreation Programming, and
Appendix G, (CIP)

Public testimony will be taken by the City Council on May 1st and May 14th at meetings to be held at City Hall within the city council chambers beginning at 6:30 PM. The council is expected to adopt the PRO Plan and amend the City Comprehensive Plan on May 14th 2012.
