JOINT STIPULATION BETWEEN CITY AND COUNTY REGARDING EXPERT TESTIMONY AND AGREED ORDER REGARDING SAME

I. JOINT STIPULATION

This Joint Stipulation is filed by Applicant King County (the "County") and the City of Sammamish ("City"), who stipulate and agree as follows:

- Shoreline Substantial Development Permit (SSDP) 2016-00414 for the East Lake Sammamish Trail (ELST) Inglewood Hill Parking Lot and SSDP 2016-00415 for ELST Segment 2B include similar trail design issues. The Hearing Examiner held an open public hearing on SSDP 2016-00415 and heard expert testimony proffered by both the County and the City on trail design issues.
- 2. The County presented the expert testimony of William Schultheiss on November 6, 2017. The City and County agree that given the similarity in trail design issues for both SSDPs, the testimony and exhibits referred to in Section 2 and 3 above are relevant to the Hearing Examiner's decision on the Inglewood Parking Lot, SSDP 2016-00414 and therefore the testimony and exhibits should be entered into the hearing record. The City and County agree that this would save time during the hearing and save the expense of having both experts—each whom resides out of the State—testify to the same information again.
- 5. The Parties ask the Hearing Examiner to accept this Stipulation and enter the testimony and exhibits described in paragraph 2 and 3 into the Hearing Examiner's record for SSDP-00414.

II. AGREED ORDER

Having considered the Stipulation of the Parties, the Hearing Examiner agrees to enter the testimony and exhibits referred to in paragraph 2 and 3 into the hearing record for public hearing for SSDP 2016-00414 and incorporate same into any final decision by the Hearing Examiner on SSDP 2016-00414.
